Shropshire Council has launched a six-week consultation into proposed reductions to its public transport budget, which would see a reduction in the number and frequency of bus services subsidised by the Council. This may see a reduction in bus services between Bishop's Castle and Shrewsbury from 5 a day to only 2 a day. The consultation ends on 6 May. Responses from the public are invited.
